Facilitator Evaluation

Generally, facilitators delivering this year were experienced DARE facilitators who delivered to small groups.

The Family Issues and Self-Esteem modules were used, reading the story rather than listening to the CD and half co-facilitated with a support facilitator. The majority plan to deliver again during 2007.

Participant Evaluation

Participants were aged between 11-14 years of age, a majority of whom were girls.

Most referrals were through their schools.

89% enjoyed the programme and 87% would recommend DBY to others. 100% enjoyed the sessions 92% said the story was awesome!

The Crime and Justice Research Centre of Victoria University has just completed an evaluation of the Year 7/8 module. The existing module was evaluated against the 16 Best Practice Principles published by the Ministry of Youth Development. Generally the programme matched up well against these Principles giving confidence that the programme is effective. Approval is being sought to release the report.
